A financial aid expert will be on hand to discuss the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and answer any questions you may have. This workshop is designed to help you navigate the application process *to help ensure you get all of the federal aid that you're entitled to*. It is EXTREMELY IMPORTANT that both students AND parents attend. If the student can not make it, it is still important that parent(s) attend, and vice versa.

TRUE STORY

A college sophomore discovered that she lost a \$10,000 aid award because she missed the filing deadline. The bad news is that this is not an isolated or unusual event. Many students miss out or lose financial aid awards because they do not file on time or they do not file correctly. Don't let this happen to you!

The deadline for filing for financial aid varies from school to school, and also by the type of funding it is. A large number of state and institutional aid have early deadlines (January and February). If you miss the deadline, you miss out on a lot of free financial aid. In addition, the financial aid process can be very difficult and confusing, and incorrect filing can have a devastating effect on your students educational funding.
